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Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope all families have had a lovely break over the holidays. Year four / five have a busy and exciting term ahead. Year Four will be participating in their 2-day excursion to Dubbo Zoo this term.

Below is a brief outline of the topics that will be covered in each subject area for this term.

Religion – This term we will be learning about the Church and Diversity. Through this, students will be expanding their knowledge and perspectives of different faiths.

Literacy– Our focus this term will be practicing our skills in publishing a wide range of texts. The students will be investigating different language structures and features, and the way they influence an audience. We will also continue to do voluntary free reading and writing, whilst also focusing on Grammar and Spelling.

Mathematics– We will be covering all strands of Mathematics this term with the goal to strengthen the children's knowledge and skills. The students will continue to practise their multiplication tables, number facts (incorporating our iPads) along with a hands-on approach to learning new concepts.

Geography – – Our geographical inquiry this term ventures into bushfires and the impacts they have on the land and communities.

Science– 'Light Shows' is our scientific inquiry this term. Through this, we will investigate how the properties of light directly affect people's lives.

Technology– Year four and Five will continue to focus on internet safety and utilizing their iPads across all subject areas. In view of our exciting learning experience, we're keen to continue to share with you our journey, so please ask your children on a regular basis to share with you the learning that has occurred during the day using our iPads.

Creative Arts– This term the students will be exploring a range of art forms, including drawing, painting, sculpture, embossing, construction and even gift making, all with a Christmas theme
