Uniform Policy

The compulsory components of the school uniform are listed.

| SUMMER SCHOOL UNIFORM | |
|--|--|
| BOYS | Blue shirt, grey shorts (not cargo style), grey school socks, black leather shoes or boots. |
| GIRLS | Blue/white check dress, brown sandals or black leather shoes and short white socks (not cut offs or knee highs). |
| Hats | A wide brim, school hat is compulsory for all children. |
| WINTER SCHOOL UNIFORM | |
| BOYS | Blue shirt, navy woolen jumper, blue/gold striped tie, long navy pants from YES Embroidery, navy school socks, black leather shoes or boots. |
| GIRLS | Blue/grey check pinafore or navy-blue slacks, navy tie, blue shirt, navy woolen jumper, navy blue socks or stockings, black leather shoes. |
| HATS | A wide brim, school hat is compulsory for all children. |
| SPORTS UNIFORM | |
| BOYS | Gold polo shirt with school logo, Royal Microfibre Short, plain white socks, predominantly white sandshoes(joggers). |
| GIRLS | Gold polo shirt with school logo, Royal Microfibre Short, plain white socks, predominantly white sandshoes(joggers), |
| Winter Sport Uniform | In winter school royal blue tracksuit pants with either matching tracksuit top with logo or royal blue polar fleece jumper with matching logo may be worn. |
| <i>Coats, beanies, scarves and gloves should all be navy blue in colour.</i> | |
| <i>Nailpolish – is not part of the St Mary's uniform and should therefore not be worn to school</i> | |
| <u>JEWELLERY & OTHER ITEMS</u> | |
| The only jewellery permissible at school is that which is worn for religious significance. If your child need to wear jewellery for this reason, please ensure a letter of explanation has been sent to the Principal. Thank you! | |
| <u>CHAINS</u> | |
| Chains may be worn only underneath clothing. They are <u>not</u> permitted during sporting activities. | |
| <u>BANGLES, RINGS BRACELETS</u> | |
| These are <u>not</u> to be worn. | |
| <u>EARRINGS</u> | |
| All earrings are discouraged. If earrings are worn a set of silver or gold stud earrings only; one in each ear, must be worn. Earrings should not be worn during any sporting activities. | |
| <u>HAIR</u> | |
| Children's hair should be maintained in a clean and tidy condition. Hair must remain its natural colour – dyes, rinses and/or tips are not permitted. Long hair (past shoulders) must be kept tied back at all times. No radical hairstyles please Hair accessories must be in school colours only, either blue or gold. | |
